#### Program Overview

#### **CONTEXT (BACKGROUND)**

Through the Akkivik Program, Raglan Mine is looking to support its host communities by supporting projects that will deliver long lasting value to its host communities. The Akkivik Program responds to the desire of creating a lasting positive legacy, beyond the Raglan Agreement.

#### **FOCUS OF THE AKKIVIK PROGRAM**

The focus of the Akkivik program is to actively support initiatives in 2018 by providing some “seed-money” and/or in-kind support to help start-up community projects.

To achieve this, it is important to build durable relationships and to develop, together, strategic approaches that are aligned with the underlying principles, governance and operating structures existing within the regional and local structure of Nunavik. The overarching concepts of advancement, self-sufficiency and working together locally will inform all aspects of this process.

The Akkivik Program follows a human capital model – It is defined by a set of values established commonly by community partners and Raglan Mine.

## VISION OF THE AKKIVIK PROGRAM

The vision of the Akkivik Program is to work together (Raglan Mine and Community partners) to provide direct and long term social and economic development, at a local level, in Kangiqsujuaq and Salluit, to address priorities with a view towards promoting community autonomy in the areas of Akkivik intervention.

## PRINCIPLES OF THE AKKIVIK PROGRAM (Core Values)

1. **Dedicated to Salluit and Kangiqsujuaq**
2. **Sustainable** (projects are environmentally, socially and economically feasible over the long-term)
3. **Capacity Building**, Self-Reliance & Empowerment (avoid burden on other local organizations)
4. **Strategic**, Proactive and Aligned (projects respond to an identified need and are consistent with company and community wishes)
5. **Bonding** (between communities & Raglan Mine)
6. **Multi-Stakeholder Driven** (synergy between multiple partners)
7. **Sharing** (community benefit)
8. **Traditional Knowledge & Practices** (transfer of knowledge)
9. **Bridges between Generations** (respect for elders and youth involvement)

### ❖ TYPES OF PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES NOT ELIGIBLE FOR SUPPORT

1. Individuals; including those seeking support for activities, such as academic studies, competing in a sporting event, travelling or raising funds for another organization.
2. Political parties; any form of political organization, politicians or candidates for public office, or political fundraising activities with the intent of funding the party itself.
3. Churches or religious activities which are exclusive to one faith community.
4. Organizations producing, distributing or seeking advertising in audio-visual media, including print or electronic media.
5. Funding of touring sports teams.
6. Activities that do not benefit the broader community.
7. Activities that will require sustained funding from the Akkivik Program over the long term (i.e.: for more than 3 years).
8. Projects that do not benefit the communities of Kangiqsujuaq and Salluit.
