AKKIVIK PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Akkivik Grants are awarded annually. Applications must be completed and returned hand delivered to the Raglan Mine Community Mining Liaison from Salluit or Kangiqsujaq, or by email [before July 29th 2020](#).

All submitted projects will be assessed based on their alignment with the vision, principles, and theme areas described on the following page.

The **PURPOSE** of the Akkivik Program is to support a positive lasting legacy beyond the Raglan Agreement for Salluit and Kangiqsujaq. The Akkivik Program follows a human capital model – it is defined by a set of values established collectively by community partners and Raglan Mine.

Our **FOCUS** is to provide seed funding and/or in-kind supports to community-driven initiatives in Raglan Mine’s host communities. With a view towards promoting community autonomy in the areas of Akkivik intervention (described below), the vision of the program is for Raglan Mine and its community partners to work together to provide direct and long term social and economic development at the local level. Successful projects will therefore be able to describe how they will contribute to positive, lasting change or opportunity for residents and the region.

Akkivik is **INFORMED BY** the underlying principles, governance and operating structures existing within the regional and local structures of Nunavik. The overarching concepts of advancement, self-sufficiency, durable relationships and working together locally will inform all aspects of this process.

Akkivik funding decisions are **GOVERNED BY** the Raglan Committee comprised of members from Salluit, Kangiqsujaq and Raglan Mine.

- Culture
- Community Health & Well-Being
- Education, Training & Leadership Development (Focus on Youth; Focus on Traditional Knowledge/Practice)
- Entrepreneurial Capacity Development & Job Creation
- Food Security through local food production or procurement
- Energy Security through alternative energy development

(PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

Applications must be completed in full including:

- The application deadline is July 29th 2020. This is determined by postmark, date of hand delivery or date received by email.
- Other funding sources for the project.
- Two reputable quotes where funds will be used to acquire goods or services from external suppliers.
- Highlight: Contact person(s) name(s), telephone number(s), and email address(es).
- Full and clear project description. If in stages, clearly outline your intended actions.
- Include any pertinent details you believe would assist the selection process.

Note:

- All applicants will be notified by mail, email or telephone when the selection process concludes.
- The goal of the Akkivik program is to announce successful applicants by September 15th, 2020.
- Missing information can jeopardize your application.

TYPES OF PROJECTS/ACTIVITIES THAT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR SUPPORT THROUGH AKKIVIK:

1. Individuals; including those seeking support for activities, such as academic studies, competing in a sporting event, travelling or raising funds for another organization.
2. Political parties; any form of political organization, politicians or candidates for public office, or political fundraising activities with the intent of funding the party itself.
3. Churches or religious activities which are exclusive to one faith community.
4. Organizations producing, distributing or seeking advertising in audio-visual media, including print or electronic media.
5. Funding for touring sports teams.
6. Activities that do not benefit the broader community.
7. Activities that will require sustained funding from the Akkivik Program over the long term (i.e.: for more than 3 years).
8. Projects that do not benefit the communities of Kangiqsujuaq and/or Salluit.
